CIRCULAR ONE

Introduction:

The 2005 Northern University Championship - Athletics will be hosted by The University of Queensland at the UQ Athletics Centre on Friday 11th March 2005. Managed by UQ SPORT, this event is presented with the support of Australian University Sport (AUS).

An official 2005 Northern University Championship - Athletics poster will be sent to your university in the near future for display. Please display this poster in a prominent position to ensure that all students have the opportunity to nominate for this event.

Event Dates:

The Championship will be held on Friday 11th March 2005 in conjunction with an All Comers Meet hosted at the UQ Athletics Centre. The competition will commence at 5.30pm and conclude around 8.45pm.

Venue Information:

The track at the UQ Athletics Centre is an international standard, synthetic facility. It is open to both the University community and the general public. The Centre boasts an 8 lane track, 2 long/triple jump facilities, 2 high jump areas, 3 shot put, 2 discus and 1 hammer circles, 2 javelin runways, and a pole vault area.

State of the art photofinish equipment will be used during the 2005 Northern University Championship - Athletics.

The 600-seat Grandstand accommodates the St Lucia Sports & Rehab Clinic, a meeting room, toilets and showers, athletics storage equipment area and excellent viewing of the 2005 Northern University Championship - Athletics.

Competition Rules and Format:

The competition will be conducted under IAAF rules with specific variations introduced by AUS.

The Championship will include the following races for men and women:

The **proposed program of events** will be available in January. Please check the UQ SPORT website for an updated program closer to the meet date – www.uqsport.uq.edu.au Changes may be made depending on registration numbers received.

The top placed athlete only from each University in each event will score points for their University. This will count towards match points.

If entrants from more than eight teams are entered for races up to and including 400m and relays, the field will be separated into 2 or more races. In this case, point scores will be determined on the basis of the best performed athlete from each University.

For all throws and the long and triple jumps all competitors will have an initial three (3) attempts with the leading eight (8) competitors having a further **one (1)** attempt.

(a) Relays

- ❑ The names of individual relay team members must be submitted to the check-in area at least 30 minutes prior to the commencement of the relay.
- ❑ All relay participants must be registered to compete in The 2005 Northern University Championship - Athletics and have completed the required eligibility forms.

(b) Check In and Marshalling

Athletes must register any time up until 60 minutes prior to their first event.. Athletes are required to produce Student ID to officials when checking-in. Athletes are expected to marshall at their event area within 10 minutes of the scheduled starting time.

(c) Uniforms

Each athlete shall wear the uniform of his or her university. Athletes who fail to wear the correct uniform may be disqualified from their event.

Entry:

Official entry is to be submitted via electronic mail or fax. The individual team members and the events that they wish to contest are to be submitted by 5pm MONDAY MARCH 7th, 2005.

Entry is \$16.50 (incl. GST) per person. Any changes or submissions received after the March 7th deadline will incur an \$11 administration fee per change. No refunds will be given for withdrawals after March 7th. The names of individual relay runners can be submitted on the night of the championship.

The Executive Officer of each competing University will be required to confirm the official eligibility of each student competing at the 2005 Northern University Championship - Athletics.

At the conclusion of the championship a tax invoice will be sent to each of the competing Universities.
