COMPETITION FORMAT

Men's & Women's Individual Championship

A maximum of seven (7) players of either gender from each university may participate.
Format: 54 holes stroke play

Men's & Women's Team Championship

Conducted as part of the individual Championship with only the four (4) best men's individual scores or two (2) best women's individual scores from each university counting towards their respective teams overall point score.

Match Play

Contested only by the four best placed teams from the Teams Championship.
Format: 18 holes match play

The 2005 Australian University Championship - Golf will be conducted in accordance with the competition rules of the Australian Golf Union www.agu.org.au and the AUS Sports Specific Rules. The AUS Golf Rules are available on the AUS website www.unisport.com.au.

Competitors will also be expected to adhere to local course rules including conduct & dress. A copy of The W.A. Golf Club Current Dress Standards has been included in this circular.

Day 5 Friday 9 December – Match Play (all day)

ELIGIBILITY

All participants must be current university students of an AUS member university. To confirm eligibility "Spot -checks" will be conducted during competition to ensure that persons participating in the event are listed on the eligibility certificates of their university.

ENTRY FEES

\$209 per competitor GST inclusive.

Payment of this entry fee will be required with registration and should be made to Australian University Sport.

The AUS Levy will be implemented in 2005. The levy for Championships will be \$2.75 GST inclusive per participants per sport. AUS will invoice universities after the close of entries.

Late Entries are at the discretion of the Host Organiser and a Late Fee of \$11 GST inclusive will apply.

LATE REGISTRATION - Late entry fee applies. Limited space*

Please follow the registration steps outlined below.

- 2) Complete and return a hard copy of the 'Eligibility Form' *signed by the Executive Officer* by fax (08) 9383 9654 or post to AUS West, PO Box 57, Claremont W.A. 6910.

Late Registration Closes – Thursday 1 December 2005.

- *Please be aware that only the Maximum Squad Size per university will be accepted on the Entry Form (7 male; 7 female). Limited additional places in the field (over the Maximum Squad Size) are available. Subsequently, any additional participants entered (over the Maximum Squad Size) will only compete in the individual event and will not count toward the places or the university points score.

ACCREDITATION

Athlete accreditation will take place **Monday, December 5th from 4.00pm to 6.00pm** at **The W.A. Golf Club**. This will be followed by a Welcome BBQ.

Each participant will be required to submit a completed 'Participation Agreement Form' (included in this Circular). Participants must pick up their accreditation in person and present their current student card to event staff for identification. If the student card does not include a photo, another form of photo identification, such as a driver's license is required.

Participants will be issued with Accreditation Cards and participants are required to bring their Accreditation Card along with their current student card to each competition. Failure to bring accreditation to the competition may result in disqualification.

Lost / misplaced Accreditation

Participants who have lost or misplaced their accreditation will be required to complete an 'Accreditation Amendment Form' at Tournament Control. A new card will then be issued.

TEAM MANAGERS MEETINGS

A meeting of all participating universities Team Managers will be held to provide updates on Championship arrangements. A representative from each university is expected to be in attendance.

The **Team Managers Meeting** will be held prior to the start of the event at **The W.A. Golf Club, Monday, December 5th at 5.00pm.**

EVALUATION MEETING

An evaluation meeting will also be held at **The W.A. Golf Club, Thursday, December 8th at 5.00pm.**

This team is a "paper" team and is NOT automatic selection in a representative fixture or an AUS endorsed tour.
