**COMPETITION FORMAT**

Men's & Women's Individual Championship

A maximum of seven (7) players of either gender from each university may participate.

Format: 54 holes stroke play

Men's & Women's Team Championship

Conducted as part of the individual Championship with only the four (4) best men's individual scores or two (2) best women's individual scores from each university counting towards their respective teams overall point score.

Match Play

Contested only by the four best placed teams from the Teams Championship.

Format: 18 holes match play

The 2005 Australian University Championship - Golf will be conducted in accordance with the competition rules of the Australian Golf Union and the AUS Sports Specific Rules. The AUS Golf Rules are available on the AUS website [www.unisport.com.au](http://www.unisport.com.au). Competitors will also be expected to adhere to local course rules including conduct & dress.

*\*Please note: one team per gender per university is eligible to enter.*

**ELIGIBILITY**

All participants must be current university students of an AUS member university. To confirm eligibility "Spot -checks" will be conducted during competition to ensure that persons participating in the event are listed on the eligibility certificates of their university.

Payment of this entry fee will be required by Friday 28 October 2005 and should be made to Australian University Sport.

**The AUS Levy will be implemented in 2005. The levy for Championships will be \$2.75 GST inclusive per participant per sport. AUC will invoice universities after the close of entries.**

"Green and Gold" teams are selected in accordance with AUS approved sport specific selection criteria and processes and are awarded Medals.

In most instances, this team is a "paper" team however on occasions, this "Green and Gold" team may compete in a representative fixture or participate in an AUS endorsed tour.
