



GREEN AND GOLD SELECTION GUIDELINES- GOLF

SELECTION COMMITTEE

The selection committee shall comprise of: (minimum of 3)

1. Australian University Sport Representative (chair) ¹
2. National or State Sporting organisation representative ²
3. Chief official (marshal) or delegate
4. Two elected members from the first sport specific meeting

TEAM COMPOSITION

- The Men's team shall consist of a maximum of 4 players.
- The Women's team shall consist of a maximum of 4 players.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Based on outstanding performances at the Australian University Games or an Australian University Championship.
- The top 4 males and females will be considered for selection.
- A competitor must have completed strokeplay over 54 holes to eligible for selection.
- Competitors shall only be considered for selection if their standard is of high enough quality that can accurately be determined by the selection committee at their discretion.

SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES

- If a competitor has played less than 54 holes, the total number completed in the competition shall count.
- INJURY - Only injuries sustained during the tournament that clearly affect the player's performance shall be considered. An injured competitor shall only be considered if they have played enough holes in the championship for their standard to be accurately determined.

¹ The AUS representative will coordinate the Green and Gold selection process and ensure that the selection of individuals into the Green and Gold team is undertaken according to the AUS Green and Gold Teams Policy and the Green and Gold Selection Guidelines for Athletics. The AUS appointed representative will chair the meetings of this committee.

² The National or State Sporting Organisation Representative, where possible, will be the head selector of the Green and Gold side.
