



GREEN AND GOLD SELECTION GUIDELINES- JUDO

As at July 2004

SELECTION COMMITTEE

The Selection Committee shall comprise of: (minimum of 3, maximum of 6)

- Australian University Sport Representative (chair) ¹
- National or State Sporting organisation representative ²
- Chief official (umpire) or delegate
- Sports Technical Convenor
- Two elected members from the sport specific meeting

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Shall be based on outstanding performances at the Australian Universities Games or an Australian University Championship
- The winner of each weight category shall be considered for selection.
- Competitors shall only be considered if their standard is of outstanding quality
- Injuries sustained during the tournament, that clearly affect the players performances, may be taken into the committee's consideration, providing the player has adequately demonstrated that they meet the required standard for selection

TEAM COMPOSITION

- The Men's division shall consist of no more than 7 competitors in the following categories:
 - Under 60kg,
 - u/66kg,
 - u/73kg,
 - u/81-+kg,
 - u/90kg,
 - u/100kg.
 - over/100kg
- The Women's division shall consist of no more than 7 competitors in the following categories:
 - u/48kg,
 - u/52kg,
 - u/57kg,
 - u/63kg,
 - u/70kg,
 - u/78kg.
 - Over/78kg

¹ The AUS representative will coordinate the Green and Gold selection process and ensure that the selection of individuals into the Green and Gold team is undertaken according to the AUS Green and Gold Teams Policy and the Green and Gold Selection Guidelines for Judo. The AUS appointed representative will chair the meetings of this committee.

² The National or State Sporting Organisation Representative, where possible, will be the head selector of the Green and Gold side.
