



## **GREEN AND GOLD SELECTION GUIDELINES - KENDO**

As at July 2004

### **SELECTION COMMITTEE**

The Selection Committee shall comprise of: (minimum of 3)

- Australian University Sport representative (chair)<sup>1</sup>
- National or State Sporting Organisation representative<sup>2</sup>
- Chief official (referee) or delegate
- Two elected members from the first sport specific meeting.

### **TEAM COMPOSITION**

- Up to five (5) competitors may be selected.

### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

- Based on outstanding performances at the Australian Universities Games or an Australian University Championship.
- Competitors shall only be considered if their standard is of high enough quality and can be accurately determined by the selection committee at their discretion.
- Only injuries sustained during the tournament that clearly affect the player's performance shall be considered. An injured competitor shall only be considered if they fought enough matches in the championship for their standard to be accurately determined.

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<sup>1</sup> The AUS representative will coordinate the Green and Gold selection process and ensure that the selection of individuals into the Green and Gold team is undertaken according to the AUS Green and Gold Teams Policy and the Green and Gold Selection Guidelines for Kendo. The AUS appointed representative will chair the meetings of this committee.

<sup>2</sup> The National or State Sporting Organisation Representative, where possible, will be the head selector of the Green and Gold side.
