



GREEN AND GOLD SELECTION GUIDELINES- MARATHON

Approved by the NSAG – 13 June 2003

SELECTION COMMITTEE

The Selection Committee shall comprise of: (minimum of 4, maximum of 6)

- Australian University Sport Representative (chair) ¹
- National or State Sporting organisation representative ²
- Chief official (umpire) or delegate
- Sports Competition Manager / Technical Convenor
- Two elected members from the first sport specific meeting

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Shall be based on outstanding performances at the Australian University Games or an Australian University Championship.
- Injuries sustained during the tournament, that clearly affect the players performances, may be taken into the committee's consideration, providing the player has adequately demonstrated that they meet the required standard for selection.

TEAM COMPOSITION

A maximum of 3 Males and 3 Females may be selected.

For all events the winner of the championship will be an automatic selection for a Green and Gold award provided that they attain the set criteria (in legal conditions) during the championships.

The criteria shall be set at the 20th placed Australian from the preceding year/s according to the top 20 rankings list issued by Athletics Australia.

Multiple Green and Gold awards can be awarded in any single event if, in the opinion of the Selection Committee, the event contained several competitors demonstrated an outstanding performance.

In judging outstanding performance the individual:

- May have broken a Championship Record
- May have performed consistently across several events
- Must have met the 20th ranked Australian Criteria as per those gaining automatic selection

If the conditions at the championship are not legal, the selection of the Green and Gold team will be left to the discretion of the Selection Committee, based on time, distance and ability of the athlete.

¹ The AUS representative will coordinate the Green and Gold selection process and ensure that the selection of individuals into the Green and Gold team is undertaken according to the AUS Green and Gold Teams Policy and the Green and Gold Selection Guidelines for Athletics. The AUS appointed representative will chair the meetings of this committee.

² The National or State Sporting Organisation Representative, where possible, will be the head selector of the Green and Gold side.
