



GREEN AND GOLD SELECTION GUIDELINES- SOFTBALL

As at July 2004

SELECTION COMMITTEE

The Selection Committee shall comprise of: (minimum of 3)

- Australian University Sport representative (chair)¹
- National or State Sporting Organisation representative²
- Chief Official (umpire) or delegate
- Two elected members from the first sport specific meeting.

TEAM COMPOSITION

- The team shall comprise of 13 players with the following line up:
 - Pitchers (2)
 - Catcher (1)
 - First base (1)
 - Second Base (1)
 - Third Base (1)
 - Short Stop (1)
 - Outfielders (3)
 - Utilities (3)

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Based on outstanding performances during the Australian University Games or an Australian University Championship, including performance in finals.
- To be considered for Green and Gold selection in a particular position, the player being nominated must have played at least half the Championship in that position (except designated hitter and utility).
- Only injuries sustained during the tournament that clearly affect the player's performance, shall be considered. An injured player shall only be considered if they played enough matches in the championship for their standard to be accurately determined by the committee.
- Teams will be asked to nominate players for consideration for selection based purely on performance during the competition at the Sports Specific Meeting.
- Player statistics during the Championship will have a major bearing on selection into the Green and Gold team.
- Selectors may use the following selection format:

¹ The AUS representative will coordinate the Green and Gold selection process and ensure that the selection of individuals into the Green and Gold team is undertaken according to the AUS Green and Gold Teams Policy and the Green and Gold Selection Guidelines for Softball. The AUS appointed representative will chair the meetings of this committee.

² The National or State Sporting Organisation Representative, where possible, will be the head selector of the Green and Gold side.
