



GREEN AND GOLD SELECTION GUIDELINES ULTIMATE FRISBEE

As at July 2004

SELECTION COMMITTEE

The Green & Gold Selection Committee shall comprise of: (minimum of 3)

- Australian University Sport Representative (chair) ¹
- Australian Flying Disc Association representative ²
- One to Three members elected by the captains at the first sport specific meeting

The Selection Committee shall comprise of at least one man and one woman.

TEAM COMPOSITION

- The Green & Gold selection shall comprise:
 - 14 – 16 players, including
 - 6-8 women and,
 - 8 -10 men
- The selection shall be made up of a balance of offensive and defensive players, handlers and receivers; as determine tactically contemporary by the Selection Committee.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Based on outstanding performances at the Australian University Games or an Australian University Championship.
- Competitors shall only be considered if their standard is of high enough quality and can be accurately determined by the Selection Committee at their discretion.
- Only injuries sustained during the Championship that clearly affect the player's performance, shall be considered. An injured player shall only be considered if standard to be accurately determined by the Selection Committee.

¹ The AUS representative will coordinate the Green and Gold selection process and ensure that the selection of individuals into the Green and Gold team is undertaken according to the AUS Green and Gold Selection Policy and the Green and Gold Selection Guidelines for that sport. The AUS appointed representative will chair the meetings of this committee.

² The National or State Sporting Organisation Representative, where possible, will be the head selector of the Green and Gold side.
