



Boardsailing (Men and Women)

Approved by NSAG – 19 March 2003

These Championships are conducted under the rules of the Australian Yachting Federation, with the following exceptions:

1. Team Size

- 1.1** Each team shall name a squad not exceeding seventeen (17) with the following breakdown:
- Course Racing: maximum 12 men (maximum 6 per weight class) and 5 women (open class)
 - Marathon Race: maximum 12 men (maximum 6 per weight class) and 5 women (open class)
 - Slalom: maximum 12 men and 5 women- Freestyle: maximum 12 men and 5 women

2. Championship Events and Weight Classes

- 2.1** The following events will be contested:

- a) Course Racing
- b) Marathon Race
- c) Slalom
- d) Freestyle
- e) Pentathlon

- 2.2** The following Weight Classes shall apply:

| Women: | Open | |
| Men: | Heavy | Equal to or over 85kg |
| | Medium | Equal to or over 75kg and under 85kg |
| | Light | Under 75kg |

Note: those competitors who fit into more than one weight class can chose a weight class

3. Championship Titles

- 3.1** The following championship titles are to be contested:

- Overall Women's Team
- Overall Men's Team
- Overall University

4. Championship Scoring

- 4.1** In determining the overall university team point scores for each class, Olympic points are to be awarded and added together to form a university team sub-total for each class. The points are to be awarded per university team in the following manner:

| | |
|----------------|--|
| Course Racing: | Best two (2) male place-getters from each weight division plus the top three (3) female place-getters. |
| Marathon: | As per "Course Racing". |
| Slalom: | Best eight (8) male plus the top three (3) female place-getters. |
| Freestyle: | Best six (6) male plus the top three (3) female place-getters. |

- 4.2** The Men's and Women's Titles will be decided by adding the sub-totals for the following in accordance with the as stated point weightings:

| Course Racing: | 3 points |
| Marathon: | 1 point |
| Slalom: | 1 point |
| Freestyle: | 1 point |

5. Judging

- 5.1** In the event that the Host cannot provide sufficient qualified independent judges the following will apply:
- Each university may nominate a judge for the Freestyle event from which four (4) judges will be selected;
 - The host may also appoint up to two (2) supplementary independent judges.

6. Presentations

- 6.1** Presentation should follow as close as possible after the completion of the event.

7. Overall University Games Points

- 7.1** The Olympic points results will be regarded as the results to count for the Overall University Games points provided that the AUC Sport Status requirement (30 competitors from 8 AUS members from 2 regions) is met in the Men's and Women's divisions of the Boardsailing competition. Should the AUC Sport Status requirement not be met the Division will not count to the Overall University Games points.
- 7.2** The Standard Point Scoring System (see table below) will be allocated for the top 16 places with remaining places receiving 1 point.
- 7.3** In the event that Universities finish on the same points in either an award division or the Overall point score, the winner will be determined by a count back in the following order:
- Number of first placing in Sports Divisions
 - Joint Winners awarded
