- a) Identify and analyse new sporting initiatives that complement the UniSport Strategic Plan
- b) Ensure the delivery of a comprehensive sport program to members that aligns with the UniSport Strategic Plan
- c) Ensure program collaboration with State and National Sporting Organisations and other appropriate stakeholders such as Sport Australia, Commonwealth Games Association and Australian Olympic Committee

National League Objectives:

- Deliver a national tournament dedicated to Australian university students
- Support university objectives of recruitment, retention and employability
- Create maximum engagement, with students involved at all levels as administrators, spectators, and players
- Create opportunities for the university and local communities to be involved including friends, families, and alumni
- Build on existing inter-university rivalry through exciting and intense competition to determine the number one university in Australia in the sport being contested
- Is valued by the NSO and supports the NSO pathway

Consideration for inclusion in UniSport national league program:

To align with UniSport strategic objectives, the following factors will be considered:

- 1. Level of interest/ support from UniSport member universities
- 2. Participation rates campus, IV, UniSport nationals, NSO nationals
- 3. Sport format open/ both gender divisions, team format
- 4. University facilities
- 5. Sport calendar suitability of mid-week games to bring sport on campus
- 6. NSO endorsement and support in competition management eg SSO/ NSO rostering officials
- 7. Sport Australia recognition/ funding status
- 8. Potential pathway to high performance and/ or international event opportunities (eg University World Cups)
