

UniSport Australia Guideline

Perpetual Trophies

Introduction

The following guideline is designed to assist members in dealing with UniSport perpetual trophies. The guideline acknowledges that all existing trophies should be retained, even if they refer to AUS, AUSF, AUSA or ATESA rather than UniSport. Where feasible, these trophies should be engraved, badged, or rebadged to include a reference to UniSport.

1. New perpetual trophies

If a new sport specific perpetual trophy is required whether due to loss, damage or as an inaugural trophy, the following conditions and procedures will apply:

- 1.1. If a trophy is lost or damaged and this can be attributed to a university, that university will cover the cost of repairs or replacement (repairs or replacement to be to the value of the previous trophy). When damage or loss cannot be attributed, procedures as per 1.2 will apply.
- 1.2. If an already established trophy is lost or irreparable and this cannot be attributed to any university, then UniSport will advertise to members for a donor/sponsor of a new trophy. If no positive response from members is forthcoming, UniSport will purchase a new trophy.
- 1.3. If a new sport specific trophy needs to be established, the following procedures are to apply:
 - a) Application for a new trophy is provided to the events department.
 - b) The application should include:
 - i. Why the trophy needs to be put in place (trophy is missing or doesn't exist)
 - ii. For what purpose it is being awarded, (overall, women's, men's etc.)
 - iii. What level of funding is necessary (provide photo of trophy planned and cost)
 - iv. What the trophy is to be called (if named after a person a short biography should also be provided)
 - v. The Nationals team consult with UniSport managers prior to making a recommendation to the UniSport Board
- 1.4. If an existing trophy needs to be replaced due to being 'full' or there is no more room to record the winners, then UniSport will first review options to extend the trophy base. If this is not feasible, UniSport will advertise to members for a donor/sponsor of a replacement trophy. If no positive response from members is forthcoming, UniSport will purchase a new trophy.
- 1.5. All new perpetual trophies are to include the wording UniSport or a UniSport logo or badge.

2. Achievements new trophies be awarded for

- 2.1. It is the objective of UniSport to keep the number of perpetual trophies to a minimum where possible. Each application for a new trophy will be dealt with on its merits, however, overall gender specific trophies are desirable. Overall trophies may be considered as may trophies for specific events within a championship.

3. Updating of trophies

- 3.1. It is the responsibility of each winning university to update each trophy it receives with appropriate plaques and/or engraving. It is expected that a measurable level of consistency will be maintained by each winner in the types of plaques and style of engraving used. Where a significant period (i.e., five or more years) has lapsed and no updating of winners has occurred, UniSport will undertake the update of the trophy.

- 3.2. When a perpetual trophy can no longer be updated, the following options will be considered by UniSport on an individual trophy basis to determine the most appropriate location for the trophy to reside. The trophy may reside with:
- The member university who won the trophy the most times
 - The member university that donated the trophy
 - The member university that the trophy was named in honor of
 - UniSport
- 3.3. All trophies will remain the property of UniSport. Universities may apply to UniSport to request the temporary use/display of a particular trophy i.e. for anniversary dinners etc.
- 3.4. Before handing over the trophy, UniSport is to photograph it and record trophy wording and all past winners.

4. Monitoring methods

- 4.1. UniSport keeps and maintains a comprehensive database on all perpetual trophies.
- 4.2. Every sport specific trophy is to be returned (at the latest) at the beginning of the Nationals competition each year. The process for the return of perpetuals to UniSport is:
- a) A UniSport staff member will provide the previous winning university a **trophy return form** to be completed.
 - b) The form acknowledges that the trophy is being returned to UniSport and outlines the condition of the trophy.
- 4.3. The process for awarding a perpetual(s) is:
- a) A UniSport staff member will provide the new recipient with a **trophy handover form** to be completed.
 - b) The form acknowledges that the trophy is being handed over from UniSport to the winning university and outlines the responsibilities of the university whilst in possession of the perpetual.
 - c) All trophies are to be kept at the sports administration headquarters of each university or at an otherwise appropriate location approved by UniSport.

5. Responsibilities of event organisers and trophy holders

- 5.1. UniSport will take full responsibility for the perpetual(s) upon receipt of the perpetual(s). The **trophy return form** will act as a confirmation of receipt.
- a) If the perpetual(s) are damaged or lost whilst in the possession of UniSport, UniSport will cover costs associated with replacing or repairing the perpetual(s).
- 5.2. A nominated representative from the winning university will be organised by competition management or UniSport to present the perpetual(s).
- a) If a representative is not available, UniSport will ensure safe delivery of the perpetual(s) to the winning university sports administration.
 - b) UniSport is responsible for ensuring that the nominated representative completes the **trophy handover form** to acknowledge receipt of the trophy.
- 5.3. Universities in possession of perpetual(s) are responsible for ensuring the perpetual(s) in possession is insured.
- a) Damages that occur from transportation or the possession of the perpetual(s) whilst in the care of the university will be liable to recovery expenses.

6. Invitational teams / International teams

- 6.1. In the instance an invitational or international team(s) wins a competition, the application of the following will apply to perpetual(s) of that competition;

6.1.1. Following the final match of the competition, the winning team will be awarded the perpetual(s) on the field of play and provided with a team photo(s) opportunity.

6.1.2. The perpetual(s) is to stay in possession of UniSport until the following year of competition.

- a) Invitational and/or international teams are not permitted to take any perpetual(s) back to their respective campuses.
- b) UniSport will be responsible for the safe-keeping and updating of perpetual(s) won by invitational and/or international teams.
