Event Crew

- Support competition managers to undertake sport specific tasks

- Assist with merchandise sales and sponsors activations

Assist with medal presentations and ceremonies including:

- Sorting and preparing medals
- Carrying medal trays and at time presenting medals
- Coordinating participants and relevant staff

Photography/Videography

- Identify and capture images &/or video of the sport, special events and ceremonies which will be used by UniSport media and marketing channels with full usage rights
- Work with journalists to supply shots or DSLR video to accompany their stories
- Meet strict edited image deadlines during event time
- Assist in the download, labeling, sorting/tagging, editing and supply of digital imagery daily during the event
