

UniSport Australia Supplement

Team duties summary

Unless otherwise stated, the person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g., team manager.

Teams that do not fulfil team duties will be fined as per the UniSport guideline [Breach of Competition Requirements](#).

3x3 Basketball

- One person from each team will be required for the duties of scoring and timekeeping for the match immediately following theirs.
- One person from each team from the second scheduled match of the day will also be required to duty the first match of the day as well as the match following their own.
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manager.

Athletics

- Each university team with 10 or more participants may be required to assist officials at designated field sites over the duration of the championships.
- It is envisaged that this will require no more than two people at any one time per team.
- It is recommended that the sport specific team manager work out a rotating roster for their designated field site.
- Each team will be required to supply a lap scorer for long distance events for each of their competitors.
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g., team manager.

AFL Nines

- Each team in the current match may be required to assist with scoring or timekeeping duties as required.
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player, e.g. team manager.

Badminton

- Each team competing in the current tie will be required to perform the duties of scoring, umpiring and line judges.
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manager.

Basketball

- Each team will be rostered to provide a duty team for a number of matches over the duration of the championships.
- The duty team will consist of two people from one team to fill the roles of scoreboard operator and scoresheet. One team from the second scheduled match of the day will also be required to duty the first match of the day
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manager.
- For Round of 16, Quarterfinals, Semifinal and Finals matches, teams will not be required to undertake duties.

Beach Volleyball

- Each team will be rostered to provide a duty team for a number of matches over the duration of the competition.
- Each team will be required to provide two people to fill the roles of first referee, and combine the role of second referee and scorer.
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manager.

Cheer and Dance

- No team duties required.

Cycling

- No team duties required.

Distance Running

- No team duties required.

Fencing

- No team duties required.

Football

- In the absence of officially appointed assistant referees, one person from each team in the current match may be required to fulfil the duties of an assistant referee, as advised by the referee.
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manager.

Futsal

- One person from each team competing in the current match will be required to score.
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manager.

Golf

- No team duties required.

Hockey

- One person from each team competing in the current match will be required to assist with timing and scoring.
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manager.

Judo

- No team duties required.

Kendo

- No team duties required.

Lacrosse 5s

- Each team will be rostered to provide a duty team for a number of matches over the duration of the championships.

- The duty team will consist of two people from one team to fill the roles of scoreboard operator and scoresheet. One team from the second scheduled match of the day will also be required to duty the first match of the day.
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manager.

Lawn Bowls

- One person from each team competing in the current match will be required to assist with scoring and one person from each team will be required to act as marker for the singles game.
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manager.

League of Legends

- No team duties required.

Netball

- One person from each team competing in the current match to assist with timing and scoring.
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manager.

Oztag

- Teams may be required to assist with scoring or other sideline duties.
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manager.

Rowing

- Teams may be required to assist with boat holding duties throughout the championships via a duty roster.
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with the team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manager.

Rugby 7s

- Each team will be rostered to provide a duty team for a number of matches over the duration of the championships.
- The duty team will consist of four people from one team to fill the roles of assistant referee (x2) and ball person (x2).
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manager.

Rugby League 9s

- Each team will be rostered to provide a duty team for a number of matches over the duration of the championships.
- The duty team will consist of two people to complete the rolls of ball persons.
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player, e.g. team manager.

Sailing

- No team duties required.

Snow Sports

- Teams will be required to perform gate keeping duties in certain events via a gate keeping roster. A comprehensive guide to gate keeping can be found [here](#).

- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with the team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manager.

Squash

- No team duties required.

Surfing

- Each competing university may be required to nominate at least one judge, who will be co-opted to judge, if required.
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manager.

Swimming

- Competing universities may be required to fill timekeeping duties via a duty roster
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manager.

T20 Cricket

- One person from each team will be required for the entire match (both innings) for the duty of scoring. This does not need to be the same person for the entire match and can be changed throughout.
- Should two umpires not be available for the match, the batting team will provide a square leg umpire, who may be changed during the innings.
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with the team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g., team manager.

Table Tennis – Teams

- Teams will be required to assist with accurately completing scoring duties across the competition
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with the team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manager

Taekwondo

- No team duties required.

Tennis

- Chair umpiring duties (if required) will be outlined to teams by the competition manager at the competition venue
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with the team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manager.

Tenpin Bowling

- No team duties required.

Touch Football

- Teams may be required during the pool games to assist with scoring or other sideline duties.

Triathlon

- No team duties required.

Ultimate

- If central timing and scoreboards are not available, team duty requirements for Ultimate are:

- One person from each team competing in the current match will be required to assist with timing and scoring.
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g., team manager.

Volleyball

- Each team will be rostered to provide a duty team for a number of matches over the duration of the championships
- Duty teams will consist of five people from one team to fill the roles of linesperson (standing) x 2, 2nd referee x 1, scorer x 1 and manual scoreboard operator x 1
- The persons fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person, competent in the sport of volleyball, associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manager.

Water Polo

- One team (appointed via a duty roster) will be required to undertake duties on the game immediately following theirs.
- Duty roles to be covered are 1 x referee, 1 x scorer, 1 x timekeeper
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manager.
