<sup>\*</sup> For a university to be eligible to contest the championship pennant, they must enter a minimum of two competitors in each event (each gender competition is considered separate). The two competitors can be entered in either the sprint distance or standard (Olympic) distance or a combination of the two distances (i.e., one in each distance).



<sup>\*\*</sup>A pennant will only be awarded if there are teams from four different universities competing in that division, and the sport is not excluded for any other reason (e.g., inclusion of combined teams).
