

# UniSport Australia Supplement

## Awards and point scoring for events

### International and Invitational Teams

#### Introduction

This supplement outlines the application of awards to relevant to international and invitational teams competing within UniSport Nationals competitions, and associated allocation of point score for member university teams towards UniSport overall awards.

*This supplement should be read in conjunction with the UniSport Guideline – Awards and point scoring for events and the Guideline – Qualification for participation.*

#### 1. Definition of teams

##### Invitational Teams

Invitational teams may from time to time apply to compete in a UniSport Nationals competition. Examples of these teams include:

- Australian based representative teams
- National Talent Identification (NTID) teams or individuals
- Development squads

##### International Teams

International teams fall within two categories.

- 1) Teams from non-Australian member universities (NA International Teams)
- 2) Teams from member universities the are located at international campuses

#### 2. UniSport awards

UniSport award three main categories of award within the UniSport Nationals;

- UniSport Overall Awards
- UniSport Spirit Awards
- UniSport Regional Awards

2.1. NA International and invitational teams are not eligible to win UniSport overall, spirit or regional awards.

2.2. NA International and invitational teams will not be included in the spirit poll voting at the events.

2.3. International teams from member universities (teams located on international campuses), are considered the same as a domestic member team, and therefore all relevant eligibility and awards and point score guidelines apply.

#### 3. Awarding of medals

3.1. Medals will be awarded to first, second and third places of each competition conducted at a UniSport Nationals event.

- a) Where two divisions are contested, the top three places will receive medals in both Div 1 and Div 2.

- 3.2. In the situation of a tie for a medal placing then both individuals/teams shall be awarded the medal for that place; i.e. if two individuals tie for second place, both shall receive silver medals, first place shall receive a gold medal and no bronze medal will be awarded (unless otherwise stipulated in the sport guidelines).
- 3.3. Where NA international or invitational teams/athletes place in the top three, they will be awarded a medal for that place in addition to the top three placed UniSport Member teams/athletes

**Example:** Member team/athlete finishes first (receives gold medal), NA international or invitational team/athlete finished second (receives Silver medal) member team/athlete finished third (receives silver medal), member team/athlete finishes fourth (receives bronze medal) .

#### 4. Awarding of pennants

- 4.1. All champions of UniSport Nationals Div 1 competitions are awarded a pennant. A pennant will also be awarded to the winners of Nationals Div 2 competitions.
- a) NA International or invitational teams are not eligible to receive a pennant.
- 4.2. Where an NA international or invitational team places first in a competition, the highest ranked UniSport Australia member university will be awarded the pennant.

#### 5. Per capita point scoring

- 5.1. International and invitational teams are not eligible to earn percapita points.
- 5.2. Points will be allocated to university members only as outlined in the example below.
