

## 2024 Australian Universities T20 Cricket Tour | India 25 November – 6 December 2024

### Position Description: Physiotherapists

UniSport Australia (UniSport) is seeking expressions of interest from **physiotherapists** to service and support the 2024 Australian Universities T20 Cricket team for the inaugural tour of India from 25 November – 6 December 2024.

#### Overview

in partnership with the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), a team of university T20 cricket players will have the opportunity to be selected for the Australian University T20 Cricket team in an upcoming tour of India.

UniSport has selected a men's squad to participate in a 12-day tour across India competing in a series of matches against universities in Mumbai and Bhubaneswar, departing Australia on 25 November and returning on 6 December 2024.

The role of the physiotherapist will be to provide medical support for the squad for the duration of the tour. The physiotherapist may be required to work with medical officials on ground at the matches where necessary.

#### Physiotherapist Duties

The following duties will be required by **physiotherapists**:

- Provide physiotherapy services to T20 Cricket participants throughout the tour, including supporting any individual UniSport-appointed team official.
- Follow team management direction and contribute to overall team success and welfare.
- Work at all times in a professional and collaborative manner, to ensure successful individual athlete and team outcomes.
- Be aware of, and comply with, team policies, procedures and processes and work in a manner which minimises exposure to risk. This includes all policies in relation to working with children and young people.
- Be flexible and prepared to take on activities outside of the prescribed role.

#### Collaboration and Reporting Structure

The Australian team will be led by three officials including coaching staff and a team manager, working collaboratively with the physiotherapist to ensure comprehensive and integrated care for the team. Physiotherapists must work in collaboration with the other team officials and ensure the health and wellbeing of all participants is the highest priority.

#### Position Requirements

- ✓ Demonstrated experience providing sports medicine services to representative level athletes, preferably across a range of sporting disciplines.
- ✓ Currently or recently working within the Australian high performance sporting system, preferably with cricket or a sports team.
- ✓ Demonstrated experience of successful travel with teams to domestic/international competition, preferably with cricket or within a team environment.
- ✓ Demonstrated ability to work in a high-performance team environment including other health professionals, athletes and team management.
- ✓ Demonstrated commitment to being reliable, competent, trustworthy as well as maintaining confidentiality.
- ✓ High standard organization and administration skills.



- ✓ High standard written and verbal communication skills.
- ✓ Knowledge of relevant anti-doping practices, procedures and rules.

### **Qualifications and Accreditations**

- ✓ Current AHPRA registered physiotherapist.
- ✓ Current APA Sports Physiotherapist title preferred.
- ✓ Current CPR accreditation as well as Working with Children Check.
- ✓ Current professional indemnity insurance, including coverage to provide services internationally (minimum \$10 million coverage).
- ✓ Completed the [Sport Integrity Australia](#) Anti-Doping Fundamentals Course (formerly Level 1), Annual Update (formerly Level 2) and Medical Practitioners Course.

### **Participation fee**

The tour participation fee is fully covered by UniSport. This includes return flights from Australia to India, accommodation and meals for the 12 days, ground transport, dress uniform and souvenirs. However, please note that there will be no payment or financial remuneration.
