Team duties summary

Unless otherwise stated, the person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g., team manager.

Teams that do not fulfil team duties will be fined as per the UniSport guideline [Breach of Competition Requirements](#).

3x3 Basketball

- One person from each team will be required for the duties of scoring and timekeeping for the match immediately following theirs.
- One person from each team from the second scheduled match of the day will also be required to duty the first match of the day as well as the match following their own.
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manager.
- Teams that do not fulfil team duties will be fined as per the UniSport guideline- [Breach of Competition Requirements](#)

Athletics

- Each university team with 10 or more participants may be required to assist officials at a designated field station/s over the duration of the championship.
- It is envisaged that this will require no more than two people at any one time per team.
- It is recommended that the sport specific team manager work out a rotating roster for their designated field station.
- Each team will be required to supply a lap scorer for long distance events for each of their competitors.
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manager
- Teams that do not fulfil team duties will be fined as per the UniSport Guideline- [Breach of Competition Requirements](#)

Australian Football

- If required a duty schedule will be created, with four people from the team allocated to perform the duties of goal umpiring (x2) and boundary umpiring (x2).
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manager

AFL 9s

- Each team in the current match may be required to assist with scoring or timekeeping duties as required.
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player, e.g. team manager.

Badminton

- Each team competing in the current tie will be required to perform the duties of scoring, umpiring and line judges.
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manager

Baseball

- One person from each team may be required for the duty of scoring. Note that scorers will be required as part of team duty if no officials are appointed to this role.

Basketball

- Each team will be rostered to provide a duty team for a number of matches over the duration of the championships.
- The duty team will consist of two (2) people from one team to fill the roles of scoreboard operator and scoresheet. One team from the second scheduled match of the day will also be required to duty the first match of the day.

Beach Volleyball

- Each team will be rostered to provide a duty team for a number of matches over the duration of the competition.
- Each team will be required to provide two (2) people to fill the roles of first referee, and combine the role of second referee and scorer.
- Teams that do not fulfil team duties will be fined as per the UniSport guideline ***Breach of Competition Requirements***

Cheer and Dance

- No team duties required.

Cycling

- No team duties required.

Distance Running

- No team duties required.

Fencing

- No team duties required.

Football

- In the absence of officially appointed assistant referees, one person from each team in the current match may be required to fulfil the duties of an assistant referee, as advised by the referee.
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manager

Futsal

- One person from each team competing in the current match will be required to score.

Golf

- No team duties required.

Handball

- One person from each team competing in the current match will be required to assist with scoring and time keeping.

Hockey

- One person from each team competing in the current match will be required to assist with scoring and time keeping.

Judo

- No team duties required.

Kendo

- No team duties required.

Lacrosse 5s

- Each team will be rostered to provide a duty team for a number of matches over the duration of the championships.
- The duty team will consist of two (2) people from one team to fill the roles of scoreboard operator and scoresheet. One team from the second scheduled match of the day will also be required to duty the first match of the day.

Lawn Bowls

- One person from each team competing in the current match will be required to assist with scoring and one person from each team will be required to act as marker for the singles game.

League of Legends

- No team duties required.

Netball

- One person from each team competing in the current match to assist with timing and scoring.

Oztag

- Teams may be required to assist with scoring or other sideline duties.
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manager.

Rowing

- Teams may be required to assist with boat holding duties throughout the championships via a duty roste

Rugby 7s

- Each team will be rostered to provide a duty team for a number of matches over the duration of the championships.
- The duty team will consist of four (4) people from one team to fill the roles of assistant referee (x2) and ball person (x2)

Rugby League 9s

- Each team will be rostered to provide a duty team for a number of matches over the duration of the championships.
- The duty team will consist of two people to complete the rolls of ball persons.
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player, e.g. team manager.

Sailing

- No team duties required.

Snow Sports

- Teams may be required to perform gate keeping duties in certain events via a gate keeping roster. A comprehensive guide to gate keeping can be found [here](#).

Softball

- One person from each team will be required for the match immediately following theirs for the duties of base umpiring or scoring. Teams that have the second timeslot of the day will be required to provide duty in the first timeslot.

Squash

- No team duties required.

Surfing

- Each competing university will nominate at least one judge, who will be co-opted to judge if and when required.

Swimming

- Competing universities may be required to fill timekeeping duties via a duty roster.

T20 Cricket

- One person from each team will be required for their match for the duty of scoring. This does not need to be the same person for the entire match and can be changed throughout.
- Should two umpires not be available for the match, the batting team will provide a square leg umpire, who may be changed during the innings.

Table Tennis – Singles

- No team duties required.

Table Tennis – Teams

- Teams will be required to assist with scoring across the competition.

Taekwondo

- No team duties required.

Tennis

- Chair umpiring duties (if required) will be outlined to teams by the competition manager at the competition.

Tenpin Bowling

- No team duties required.

Touch Football

- Teams will be required during the pool games to assist with scoring or other sideline duties.

Triathlon

- No team duties required.

Ultimate

- If central timing and scoreboards are not available, the following shall apply:
- One person from each team competing in the current match will be required to assist with timing and scoring.

Volleyball

- Each team will be rostered to provide a duty team for a number of matches over the duration of the championships.
- Duty teams will consist of five (5) people from one team to fill the roles of linesperson (standing) x2, 2nd referee x1, scorer x1, and manual scoreboard operator x1.
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person, competent in the sport of volleyball, associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manger

Water Polo

- One team from the previous game will be appointed to undertake duties on the game immediately following theirs. Teams that have the second timeslot of the day will be required to provide duty in the first timeslot.
- Duty roles to be covered are referee x1, goal judge x1, scorer x1, and timekeeper x1.
- The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team or university and does not necessarily have to be a player e.g. team manager
