

UniSport Australia Circular

Kendo Supplementary Rules – June 2023

1. Purpose

This circular is to be read in conjunction with the UniSport Competition Guidelines for Kendo and has been prepared by the Kendo Board of the Australian Kendo Renmei (AKR) in order to clarify procedural matters related to the conduct of the event, as well as keeping the event in accordance with AKR regulations.

2. Competition Points

2.1. Final placings in each division will be awarded the following points (not that all points will be tallied to determine the winner of each overall pennant):

- a) 1st place: 3 points
- b) 2nd place: 2 points
- c) 3rd place: 1 point

2.2. Team Kyu Grade competition points will combine with the women's points, and the Team Open Grade competition points will combine with the men's points, and thus contribute to each.

2.3. If universities finish on the same points in either an award division or the overall point score, the winner will be determined by a count back in the following order:

- a) Number of first placing in sport divisions.
- b) Join winners awarded.

3. Fighting Spirit Awards

The allocation of Fighting Spirit awards across divisions will be decided by the competition manager taking into consideration competitor numbers. The recommended allocation is as follows:

- A Kyu Individual Male competitor
- A Kyu Individual Female competitor
- A Dan Individual Male competitor
- A Dan Individual Female competitor
- A Kyu Teams competitor
- An Open Teams competitor
