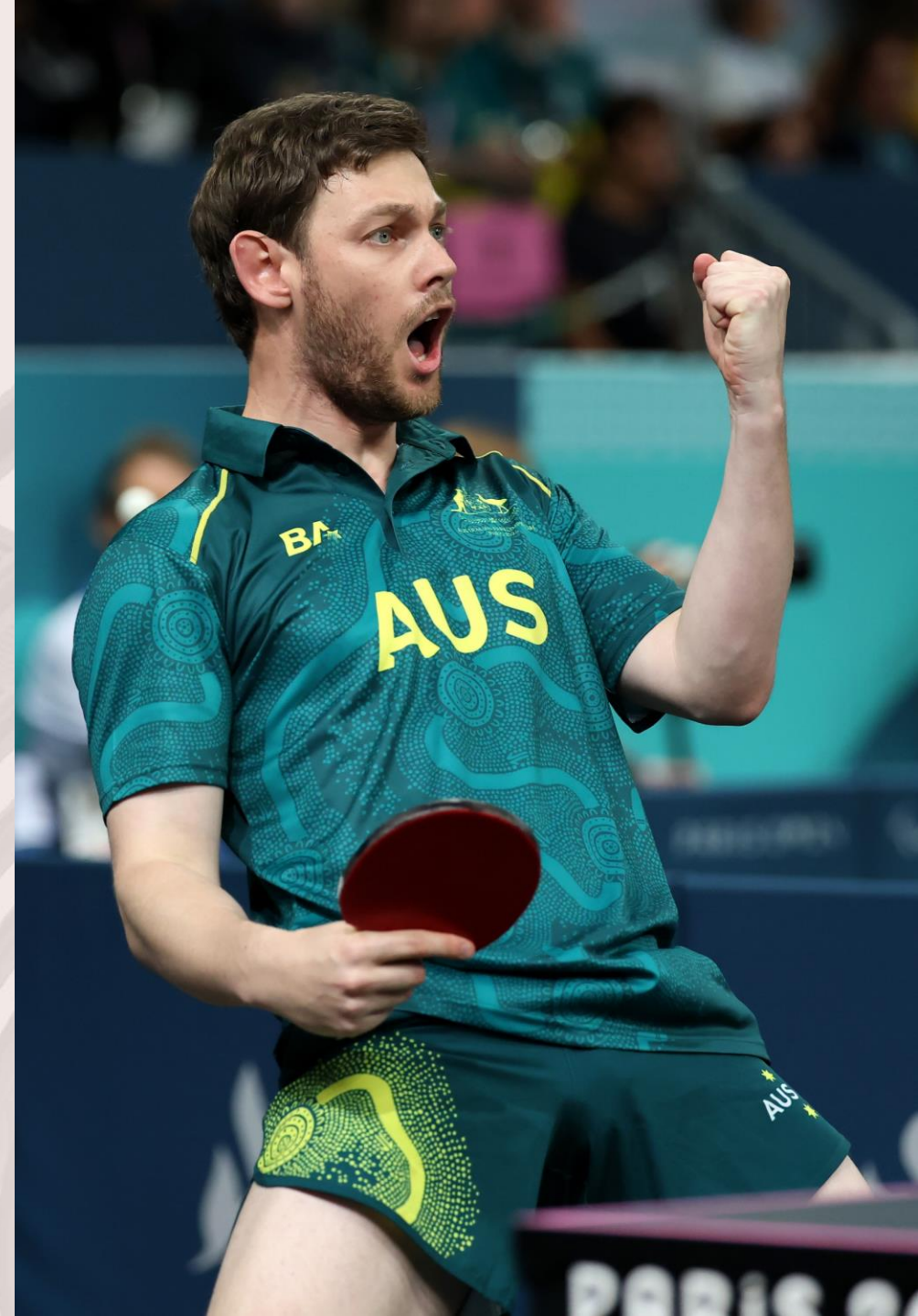

Barriers and Success in Engaging with Tertiary Education.

- 31% of able and para-athletes that attended the 2024 Paris Olympics were engaged in Tertiary Study.
- 50% of athletes experience unemployment after retiring from sport.
- 30% of athletes experience de-categorisation in an Olympic cycle.
- Australian Sports Foundation survey finds 46 per cent of athletes earn less than \$23,000 per year.
- 6 out of 10 athletes experience depression or anxiety after retirement.
- “A degree or diploma can open doors to a wider range of job opportunities beyond those related to sport”. Studying allows them to transition smoothly into various career paths after their athletic careers.
- Tertiary Education presents an opportunity to gain valuable life skills that can enhance athletic performance.
- Exploring identity outside of sport-Tertiary education provides opportunities to nurture academic interests and build social connections.
