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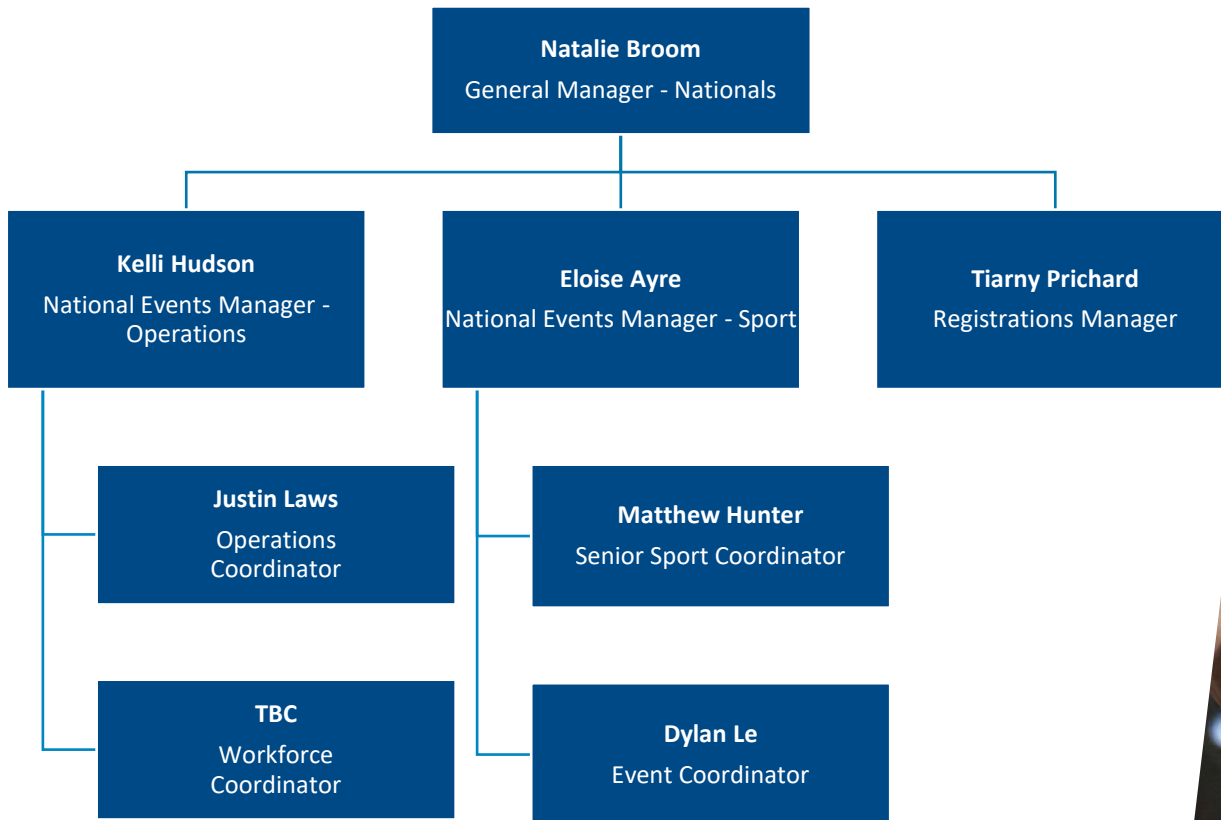

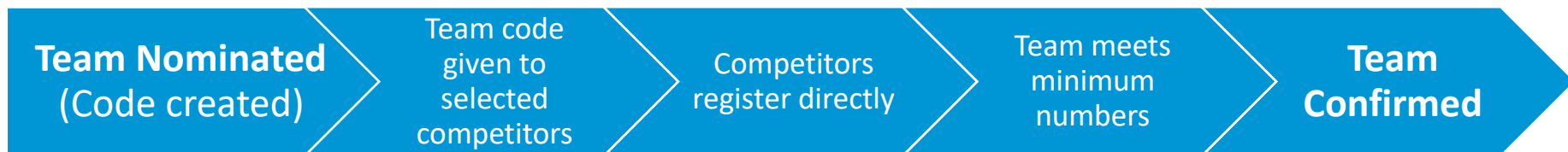
## Registrations:

Where possible please do this PRIOR to the close of Early Bird registrations.

# Team nominations

- Please DO NOT nominate a team in EVERY competition unless you intend to bring one in every comp
- Easier for us to add late teams than it is to remove teams that fall over at the last minute

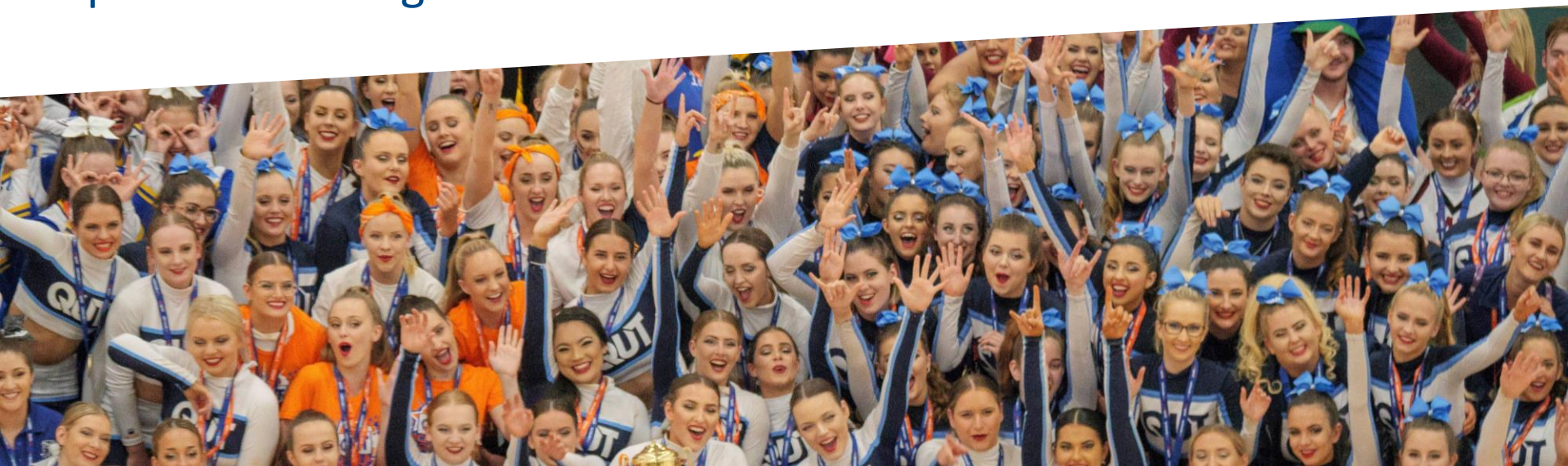


# Team nominations cont.

If you only remember one thing, remember this.....

**Please keep Tiarny in the loop with how your teams are progressing. If they are 'on the fence' let her know. We can account for this in our planning processes**

Tiarny will keep in touch with all members regarding the status of their teams and how close they are to minimum numbers in the lead up to close of registrations



# Minimum numbers and cross registrations (XRego)

- Each sport guideline outlines the minimum numbers required to constitute a team (There is a Min and Max squad size supplement to help with this)
- Teams must reach minimum numbers to be eligible for the competition
  - Minimum numbers must be met by the team withdrawal deadline

## Cross Registration

- Participants can compete in more than 1 sport at Nationals (at the discretion of their Uni)
- Each additional sport will cost \$55 (managed through the rego system)



# XRego cont.

- XRego limits for sports are outlined in the sport guidelines
- There is no 'primary' sport – so if a player is XRego in Touch and Tennis, it counts as a XRego for **BOTH** teams
- We highly recommend that XRego's are not used to reach team minimum numbers

*Note: in 2023, using XRegos to meet minimum numbers will not be allowed.*

There are no XRego restrictions for cheer and dance, cycling, fencing, judo, kendo, rowing and taekwondo.

Participant cross registrations in any of these sports will count towards the XRego numbers for the other sport entered.

# Team withdrawal process

- First time it will be implemented for Div 1 (has been implemented for NUCs)
- Please read Guideline
- Teams must be at minimum numbers by this date, if not UniSport can make the decision to remove the team
- If teams are withdrawn AFTER the deadline the uni will be invoiced for:
  - Cost of all participants registered in the team at that point plus a \$200 withdrawal fee
- **Deadline – 5pm Friday 26 August**
- **Please do not withdraw a team straight from fuse. Please email Tiarny to withdraw a team**



# Competitor Eligibility

Participant eligibility checks must be complete by  
**5pm Friday 9 September**

# Nationals Div 1 and Div 2

## Competition structure

Div 1 and Div 2 structure based on the number of teams nominated in the competition

- Competitions with teams that have 12 or more team nominations will be 2 divisions (under the following size parameters

- 12-19 teams entered: Div 1 - 8 teams; Div 2 - remaining teams
- 20-25 teams entered: Div 1 - 12 teams; Div 2 - remaining teams
- 26+ teams entered: Div 1 - 12 teams; Div 2 - remaining teams





# Promotion and relegation

- Team seedings are based on the final rankings from the 2019 Nationals
- For competitions with two divisions, promotion and relegation will take place after the initial pool rounds (likely mid to late on day 2 of the competition)
- The top 2 ranking teams in Div 2 and the bottom 2 ranking teams in Div 1 will be promoted and relegated respectively
- No university can have 2 teams in Div 1 (if a Div 2 team finishes in the top 2 after the initial pool games, the promotion place will be offered to the next ranked first team)



# How many teams can we nominate?

- [Guideline: Qualification for participation in UniSport Events](#)
- Only **ONE** team can be nominated in a Div 1 only competition
- If a competition has two divisions, up to **TWO** teams may be nominated
- Up to two teams can be entered in a Div 2 competition (if the university does not have a team in Div 1)
- UniSport will identify when team nominations reach a level that confirms a competition will be two divisions
