Event Medical Coverage – First Responders

UniSport Australia will be utilising qualified Sports Trainers (Level 1 & Level 2) for all official medical coverage needs. They are designated first-responders to all injuries and illnesses that present during competition.

All Sports Trainers must hold currency in the following to be eligible and engaged to assist:

- HLTAID009 – Provide CPR
- HLTAID011 – Provide First Aid
- Level 1 / Level 2 Sports Trainer accreditation
- Working with Children Check / Blue Card

A Sports Trainer is not simply a First Aider, but an individual with experience in managing sporting injuries and incidents, trained to provide quality and immediate injury care to athletes.

Sports Trainers also have skills and knowledge in the areas of sports taping, soft tissue injuries, on-field transport, stings, and allergies, as well as first aid skills such as CPR, wound and fracture management.

All Sports Trainers will also be following the current Australian Concussion Guidelines for Youth and Community Sport and follow the necessary steps for any athlete that is suspected of sustaining a concussion.

Level 1 Sports Trainers have received training including:

- Concussion Management
- Sports Taping (Ankle, Thumb and Finger)
- Transport of the Injured Athlete
- Nutrition and Hydration
- Drugs in Sport

Level 2 Sports Trainers are more experienced and have proficiency in all Level 1 Sports Trainer content, as well as:

- Advanced Sports Taping (Knee, Shoulder, Elbow and Achilles)
- Spinal Injury Management
- Injury Prevention Programs
- Concussion Management
- Sports Massage
- Wound Management
- Athlete Wellbeing and Mental Health
