Contactless Payments



Phone Wallet Payments:

- Can use phone wallet or card to directly tap onto buses and trains, but will pay regular fare price of \$2.40 for 2 sections (3.2km or less), \$3.50 for travelling within 3 hours
- Amount charged is capped at the day rider fee of \$7 - most athletes will be using the go anywhere fee of \$3.50

SmartRider Payments:

- Athletes can buy a standard SmartRider from SmartRider Retail Outlets (10% discount on all fares)
- To receive a 20% discount, athletes can set up Auto Load, which adds money via direct debit from chosen bank account when balance is low.

Transperth Fares



2 Section Fare

- Cheapest fare option for short trips of 3.2km or less
- Used on single bus, train or ferry for one-way journey only

Go Anywhere Fare

- Standard Fare to travel anywhere within a 3 hour time window, no distance limit.
- Includes any combination of trains, buses and ferries

Day Rider Fare

- Unlimited travel for the entire day within Transperth network, including buses, trains and ferries.
- Do not need to purchase separately, the system will automatically track your travel and caps daily spending at the DayRider rate (once cap reached, any additional travel is free)
 - Standard DayRider: \$7
 - Concession Fare: \$3.20

Concession Fare

- University and TAFE students studying in WA may be eligible for concession fares through a Tertiary SmartRider (Approval needs enrolment in an approved course + study load)

Free Transit Zones

Every Sunday Free

- Sunday Free for all contactless payments on all types of transport, just tag on and off as usual
 - Does not apply to late night Saturday night services

Free Transit Zones

- To access Free Transit Zones, athletes must start and finish the journey at City West Station, Perth Underground or Bus Station, Elizabeth Quay Bus or Train Station, McIver Station or Claisebrook Station
- Still tag on and off

CAT Busses

- Operate in Perth CBD, Joondalup and beach service to Scarborough Beach
- Completely free!

Airport Travel Options



Airport to Perth CBD

- Airport Central Station serves Terminals 1 & 2
- Travel Time to Perth CBD: Approx 18 min.
- Tag on/off using:
 - Visa/Mastercard
 - Apple Pay/Google Pay
 - SmartRider

Perth CBD to Airport

- Catch the Airport Line from Perth Station, Exit at: Airport Central Station for T1/T2
- Redcliffe Station + Route 292 Bus for T3/T4

Routes

- Route 940 - Connects Elizabeth Quay Station with Redcliffe Station
 - Useful if you are staying near Elizabeth Quay or connecting to T3/T4
- Route 292 - Shuttle connection between Redcliffe Station and T3/T4 terminals
- Route 37 - Connections Airport Central Station with Oats Street Station via Belmont Forum
 - More useful for local connections than CBD travel
