

RISE eLearning

How to access, log in, and complete the RISE eLearning module

RISE eLearning is UniSport's online learning module on preventing gender-based violence in university sporting clubs and intervarsity teams. RISE stands for Respect, Inclusion, Safety & Equality. This guide walks you through creating an account, accessing the module, and completing the course.

Before you start: you won't be able to see or access any of the course content until you've created an account or signed in, so that's the first step below.

1. Create an account or sign in

Before you can see or access any of the RISE eLearning content, you'll need to create an account or sign in. Start here — go to the sign-in page below:

unisport-grow-your-game.thinkific.com/users/sign_in

If you're new to the platform (first time completing any UniSport online courses):

1. Open the sign-in page above.
2. Select **Create an account** below the sign-in form.
3. Enter your name, email address and a password, then follow the prompts to finish setting up your account.
4. You'll be signed in automatically and taken to the course.

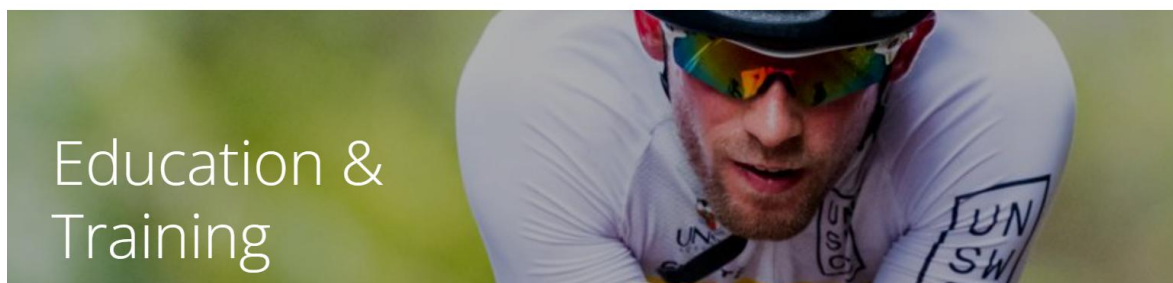
If you already have an account:

1. Open the sign-in page above.

2. Enter your email and password and select **Sign in**.
3. If you've forgotten your password, select **Forgot password?** and follow the reset instructions sent to your email.

2. Access the course material

Once you've created your account and are signed in, you can get to the RISE eLearning module in one of two ways:

- Directly, via the course link: unisport-grow-your-game.thinkific.com/courses/take/RISE
- Via the UniSport website: go to unisport.com.au > *Members* > *Gender-Based Violence Prevention* > *RISE Education – Online Learning Modules*, then select **View** next to the RISE eLearning entry.

3. Completing the module

Once you're signed in, you'll land on the course overview. Work through the content in order - each section builds on the last.

Fill in the participant information form

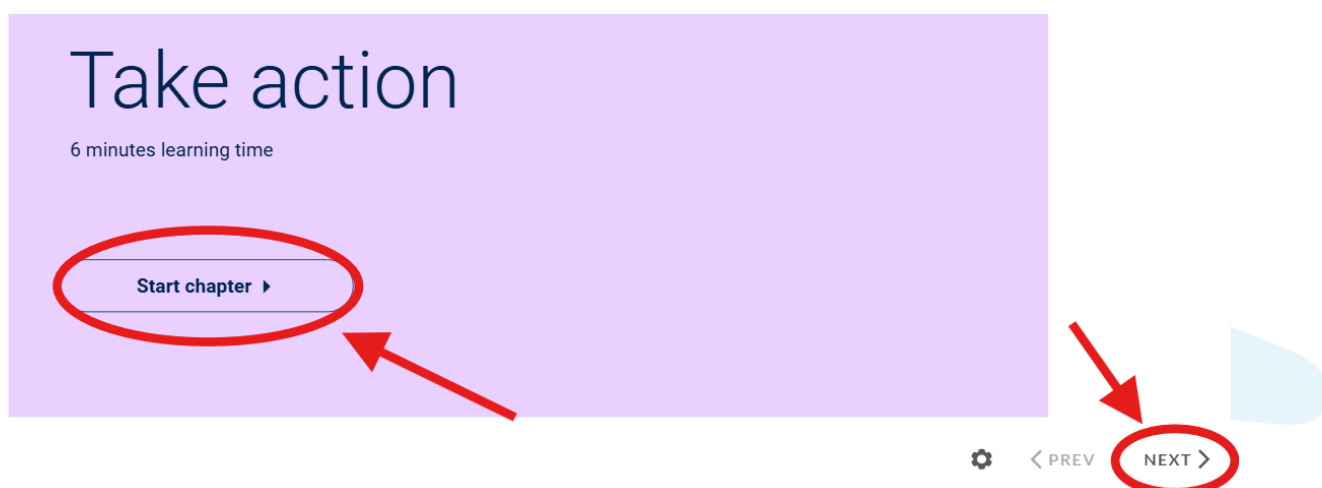
Early in the course, you'll come across a Microsoft Form embedded directly in the lesson - this is the participant information form. Complete all the required fields in the embedded form itself before moving on to the next section; it won't be sent to you separately, so don't skip past it.

You must click through all the content before you can move on.

You need to **fully complete each section before you can progress**. Simply skipping ahead using the sidebar will not unlock later sections.

Make sure you:

- Scroll through and view **every screen**
- Watch each **video**
- Complete every **activity**
- Click through all the content before selecting **Next**



Once you have completed the embedded content, select 'Continue' to move to the next chapter. This will mark and save your progress.

The scenario (Chapter 6) opens in a new browser tab

Chapter 6 involves an interactive scenario. When you reach it, it will open in a new browser tab rather than inside the course window itself.

- Complete the scenario fully in that new tab.
- Once you've finished it, close the scenario tab (or simply switch back) and return to the original RISE eLearning tab to continue the course.
- If the new tab doesn't open automatically, check that your browser isn't blocking pop-ups for the Thinkific site, then try again.

Tip

Keep the original course tab open in the background while the scenario is open in its new tab - you'll need it to continue once the scenario is done.

4. Taking the quiz

Most chapters end with a compulsory quiz. You'll need to answer the quiz questions for a chapter before the platform will let you move on to the next one - so once you've clicked through all the content in a chapter you'll be directed to the quiz at the end.

You will need to get the quiz correct to progress to the next chapter, however, you will be offered the opportunity to retry.
